INTRODUCTION

This Worksheet and Guide is meant to help you prepare your application prior to opening the online Submittable portal. You will find a comprehensive preview of all of the questions and elements of the application, alongside some additional explanation. Then you will find instructions for using Submittable and several ways to seek help or to find answers to your questions.

Before beginning your application, first decide whether this award will be suited to you according to your meeting the eligibility requirements, your alignment with BANF's goals and values informing the design of this award, and your intention to meet the commitments that are expected of awardees. Awardees will commit to participating in an 18-month learning community to share experience, opportunity, and inspiration with other BANF Awardees.

The Award Guidelines also include a description of how your application will be reviewed, how the awards criteria were developed, how panels of reviewers are selected, and how the reviewers use the criteria to recommend awards.

Understanding the awards criteria and how the reviewers will read your application should help you to prepare your answers to questions in the application and to measure the strength of your application.

The reviewers will rely entirely on the application materials as they have been submitted by the applicant. While they consider every part of the submitted application, they will not perform additional research to flesh out materials, or consider websites or social media channels, or materials beyond those submitted by the applicant, though they may bring their personal experience to bear if they have attended, read, or experienced public presentations, publications, or exhibitions of work by the artist.

SUGGESTED STEPS

1. Contact your advocates and talk with them about the award and your upcoming request. Share the Awards Guidelines with your advocates so you and your advocates both understand what is expected.
2. Make sure you have correct email addresses for your advocate. Ask your advocate to safelist notifications@email.submittable.com so emails are not flagged as junk.
3. Gather your documents, answers to questions, audio or video files, and links to audio or video recordings. Check that your file types are acceptable for each submission. Check that your links to audio or video recordings are valid.
4. Open your Submittable application. Safelist notifications@email.submittable.com so emails are not flagged as junk.
5. **Save your work** periodically as you make your way through the application, for example at the end of each section that you complete. To save your work, scroll to the very bottom of the page to find the **“Save Draft”** button. You can return to your application anytime by logging back into your Submittable account.
6. Let your advocates know when you have sent them a request from Submittable. You can check if your advocates have submitted their statements of support in your Submittable account. You can also resend your request if necessary.

The application may take up to 10 hours to complete. Additional time may be necessary for you to craft your narrative and video responses. We designed the narrative questions with the belief that responses used here could also serve applicants in their own advocacy efforts.
